Erasmus+ at VEVU

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe.

Its budget of €14.7 billion will provide opportunities for over 4 million Europeans to study, train, gain experience, and volunteer abroad.



Erasmus+ impacts

Key findings:

On average, Erasmus students have better employability skills after a stay abroad than 70% of all students.

By the time the students return, they have increased their employability advantage for by 42% on average.

While 64% **of employers** consider an international experience as important for recruitment, on **average 92% are looking for transversal skills** such as openness to and curiosity about new challenges, problem-solving and decision-making skills, confidence, tolerance towards other personal values and behaviours.

More than **one in three Erasmus students who did a job placement** abroad **were hired or offered** a position by their host company....

Erasmus+ VEVU OUTCOMES

34 realized mobilities. (by November 2018.)

9 incoming mobilities: 3 non-teaching staff (STT), 5 teaching staff STA and 1 student SMS.

26 outgoing mobilities: 3 students SMP, 2 students SMS; 12 teachers STT and 6 teachers STA; 3 STT non-teaching staff.

Recognized ECTS credits:

In total 22 ECTS credits (20% fully recognized; 40% partially recognized)

40% mobilities without recognition ECTS credits (final assignments).
