- ✓ Bachelor programme students must have completed a minimum of 40 ECTS credits at their home university degree programme
- ✓ Working knowledge of the English language (reading, speaking, writing)
- ✓ Previous clinical experience, either professional or internships
- ✓ Motivation and expectations towards the implementation in own professional career

Ranking based on motivation and English language skills will be performed by each participating University for their students.
